Celebration of Children's Day – for the occasion of Children's day on 14th November we have invited Lioness Club president Mrs. Pramila Walunj. We have specially invited the community beneficiaries who were part of study class and Balbhava and they went to hostel for further study. One of the participant Radah said "I want to become like Prabha tai and want to do social work for the marginalized community people. Also I want to become a police" it has great achievement for the program and NGO's initiatives.



Conducted PRATIBIMB training program with Swami Vivekanad School Talegaon – PRATIBIMB is a training module for adlescent has covered career guidance, self awareness, Reproductive Health, Love and affection, Gender and information on Sexually transmited dieases. It has six days training module. Approximately 27 girls of the school got benefit of the program.



Celebraion of World AIDS Day – On the occasion of International World AIDS Day, Work for Equality has conducted awareness program for the employess of Top Tech Company in Talegaon. The company having maximum female employess from marginalized community. Approximately 150 women’s got opportunity to understand scientific information on HIV/AIDS.



Celebration of International Human Rights Day 10th December – we have organized and facilitated Mahila Melava on the ocssion of International Human Rights Day. Violence agaisnt Women was the theam of Melava. On the ocssion we have invited Police Inspactor Mr. Sanjay Nikam Sir, Adv. Ranjana tai Bhosale, Counselor Devsena. Information on Mahila Suraksha Samiti, Domestic violence Act 2005, Women and Violence and counseling on Adolescent girls has been provided during the program. Approximately more than 200 women’s and students got benefit the program. This program had conducted with the association of Lioness Club Talegaon and Bharati Sanskar Kendra Indori.



Rally – Violence Against Women - after the incidence of Delhi and Kasarwadi Rape cases, Work for Equality has organized rally on 22th December 2012. The main objective was to spread awareness against the issue and also made pressure group from community to raise their voice on violence against women. Lioness, Lioness, Rotary Club, Friends of Nature and other reputed and responsible NGO’s , school students and teachers in Talegaon came under one banner of “Chuppi Todo” and spread awareness. Celebration of International Youth Day (12th Jan 2013)- Work for Equality with association of Indrayani College x students organization has organized workshop on Human Rights for the Indrayani Junior College students. Mr. Milind Chavan from Masum organization gave guidance to the participants on Human Rights. During the workshop, Rotary Club president Mr. Ashok Kalokhe, vice Principal Mr. Sunil Ovhal , Prof. Pawar, YHRI members and members of x students organization Ms. Pradnya Doshi, Sudha Joshi , Heena Doshi, vice chief executive officer of the town Mr. Ganesh Kakade and Mr. Dinesh Shaha from Education department were also participated in the program.

Throughout the session Mr. Milind Chavan has mainly focused on women’s secondary status of the society. He shared her health, educational, economical and social condition of the society. He not only focuses on the issue but also helped participant to understand the causes of women’s secondary status. He said Cast, Class, Religion are the main causes of women’s secondary status. If we want to enhance women’s status we need to criticize all these systems once again. During the workshop, facilitator has motivated participant to raised their voice on the issue of violence against women. Approximately 200 students got benefit of the program.

Human Rights Training Program for Youth: - Work for Equality with the association of Lioness Club Talegaon has run Human Rights Training program for the youth. This program has focused on to spread awareness about human rights and our responsibilities. Through the program we have covered eight schools and colleges and reached around 1800 students. This program helped to sensitized youth about social issues like violence against women, poverty, unemployment, cast discrimination, illiteracy, issue of child labor etc....The outcome of the program has number of students now also participated in Human rights movement and want to do work for to get human rights to all.



Street play on Anemia – some of the Human Rights trained participants came forward and take up the issue of Anemia. They performed street play on Anemia on their own college, Railway station and program organized by CYDA NGO in Forbes Marshall company. This experience not only gave them knowledge on Anemia but also developed their confidence



Rally on One Billion Raising – work for equality has actively participated campaign named one billion raising with pune NGO's group. This campaign was orgnaized on the occasion of 14th valentine day. The objective of the campaign was to increase dignity of women and raised voice violence against women.



Participate in different forum – Work for Equality is also participated in two forum with Gabriel company Chakan and Assistant commissioner office Pune, our role is to provide guidance on sexual harassment against women. Till we have conducted 8 training program for the forum.



Livelihood program for the Landewadi community girls- Work for Equality with the association of Forbes Marshall Kasarwadi has conducted three months livelihood training program according to their interest area with objective to develop inters of community girls/women to think about economical independence . we have providing livelihood trainings on parlor, making jewelry, Mendhi, Zula , ceramic etc.... after training program either helped them to start their own income generation activity or refer them for suitable job.

Other activities – Work for Equality has invited some of the programs organized by reputed Schools, colleges and NGO's in Talegaon. Adarsha School and college teachers parents forum and Ganesh Vachanalay Talegaon, Indrayani College and Pathak Coaching classes has invited us to provide guidance and shared experience while working on the issue of women.



Livelihood opportunity through providing stall in Diwali festival – Work for Equality with association of Gabriel company has organized two days livelihood program for the SHG's members. Self Help Groups associated with Forbes Marshall and JCB has participate in program.
